- 2. All applications must be signed by your organization's responsible person. This person is accountable for your group following the rules and regulations in order to help keep the parade safe for everyone.
- 3. There is a limit of 100 entries in the 2012 parade.

- 2. This is a fun, family event. All entries should reflect this. No offensive or lewd floats or signs will be allowed.
